The 'Handyman challenge' contest is a competition involving manual skills whereby the animators judge the quality and the speed of two tests, related to different fields. Participating students truly experience the competition while having fun and learning.



INTERACTIVE TECHNOLOGY WORKSHOPS

These workshops present technology occupations where the job prospects are excellent. A thirty-minute activity enables students to learn a discipline while being accompanied by an expert trainer.

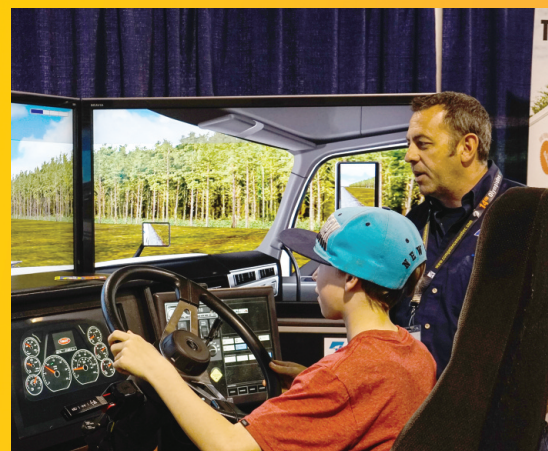
